

Lifeguard Agreement

Summary: Ensures the safety of patrons of Stamford Bridge Community Pool (SBCP) by preventing and responding to emergencies.

Minimum job requirements: Provide copy of Lifeguard certificate and show evidence of maintaining skills and renewing qualification as required.

Duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the SBCP using whistle communication as outlined in EAP; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency.
- 2. Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
- 3. Presents professional appearance and attitude at all times, and maintains a high standard of customer service. Punctuality essential.
- 4. To wear appropriate lifeguard clothing, bare feet and accessible whistle.
- 5. No mobile phone usage pool side.

Specific duties at Stamford Bridge Community Pool:

Please read and then sign and date this agreement.

- 1. Open pool side door.
- 2. Test pool water with pool testing strip. Enter reading into pool testing record folder. If test is within recommended guidelines proceed to 3 if pool water is outside recommendations inform pool caretaker and do not let patrons into the pool. Pool will be closed until situation is resolved.
- 3. Remove pool cover. Lane swimming sessions require the lane marker rope putting in situ.
- 4. Open both pool side doors to allow access of the patrons from the changing rooms.
- 5. Collect any money if required.
- 6. At end of swim session reapply pool cover and ensure pool side is swept of excess water.
- 7. Lock pool side doors to changing rooms and ensure the pool hall lights are turned off.
